

# DELAWARE PMP AWARE

**PMP AWARE** is a significant upgrade from the previous system. It's easier to use — patient data is available with just two clicks — and enhanced, meaningful analytics will help you improve patient safety by detecting risks or trends. Key features include:

- Timesaving NARX score gives you a patient-overdose risk assessment in seconds.
- Batch requests (generation of multiple patients' reports in one click).
- Prescriber report to compare your prescribing with other prescribers in your field and specialty, as well as a summary of your PMP use — emailed every three months.
- Data-sharing with many states, with new states added regularly.
- Integration potential within your EHR, with a single sign-on.
- Ability to assign one or more delegates, with an audit trail back to you.
- Find resources like a PMP user guide, MAT providers, and educational materials, all in one convenient place.

## REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY FOR ALL DELAWARE-CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE REGISTRATION (CSR) HOLDERS:

- Failure to register could result in disciplinary action.
- Running a PMP query for a patient is mandatory if you:
  - Prescribe opioids to treat chronic pain.
  - Prescribe more than a seven-day supply of opioids in an acute setting.
  - Prescribe opioids and benzodiazepines.
  - Think that a patient could potentially be at risk for substance abuse.

## REGISTRATION TAKES LESS THAN A MINUTE:

- If you can successfully query the PMP, you're already registered.
- If not, register or re-register at [PMPAWARE.net](http://PMPAWARE.net).
  - To reset your password:
    - Click on “Reset your password.”
    - Enter your email address and click “Request Password Reset.” You **must** use the email address used when you originally registered with the PMP.
    - A link will be emailed to you within seconds to reset your password. Note: The link is active for 20 minutes.
  - Once your password is reset:
    - All required fields must be filled out for your registration to be complete.
    - Include your specialty — it's critical to finalize your registration and to receive your prescriber report, which is used to compare your prescribing behavior with others in your field, as well as your PMP usage.
- You can approve or deny delegate requests to conduct PMP AWARE searches for you. Delegates must each apply for their own account. Each search conducted will have an audit trail back to you.

## GET A QUICK PATIENT ASSESSMENT WITH RISK INDICATORS

- These consist of Narx scores (for narcotics, sedatives, and stimulants), an overdose risk score, and additional state indicators.
- They provide at-a-glance information designed to draw awareness to the presence of PMP data.
- You'll have a quick assessment, with the ability to drill down to the details when needed.



## SEARCH MULTIPLE PATIENTS WITH A BULK FUNCTION

- Import Excel sheets of a day's patients or simply enter them into the search field to run a bulk patient search.
- Save time by allowing a delegate to conduct these searches.

## GET A PRESCRIBER REPORT CARD

- Your report card will be emailed to you automatically if you have a DEA number and prescribe controlled substances.
- See your own prescribing rates compared with others in your field and specialty.
- See your PMP usage as well as your delegates' usage.
- See if you or other providers have prescribed potentially dangerous combinations of controlled substances.

## USE THE MY RX SEARCH TOOL

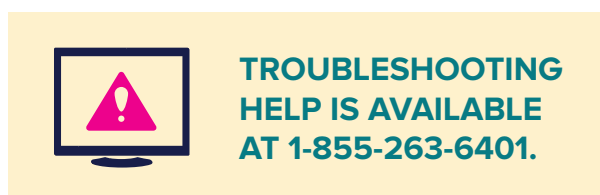
- Run your own DEA number to see what prescriptions have been filled using your DEA number during a specified time period.
- Check for prescribing discrepancies or to verify your own records.
